The Contractor successfully completed two partial cycles of the gate test this evening.

- The gate was opened approximately 1-inch and left open for approximately one hour, with no flow at the LLO discharge.
- The gate was closed, reopened to approximately 15-inches, and was successfully closed. No flow was witnessed at the LLO discharge.

The Contractor is performing a dive inspection in the morning and will then resume testing, performing a complete opening/closing cycle of the gate.
